

Thinking About Arabic Sounds

- Word 1: مَحَلَّ Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? Short vowels sound more precise - shadda is pronounced.
- Word 2: جَبَل Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? Short vowels sound more correct in A.
- Word 3: مُفَاصَلَة Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? The ص is pronounced correctly in B
- Word 4: رَخِيص Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? The long vowel doesn't sound very pronounced in either.
- Word 5: اِشْتَرَى Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? Clip A sounded overpronounced.
- Word 6: رُوح Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? Both "ز" and "ر" sound correctly pronounced.
- Word 7: لَيْل Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? Both sound similar, but the vowels sound more correctly pronounced in A.
- Word 8: الْخَارِج Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? The "ي" in B is pronounced correctly - in A, "ي" sounds more like a "ز"
- Word 9: زَار Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? The long vowel and the "ر" are of the right length.
- Word 10: تَعَال Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? The long vowel and ر are more present in B.
- Word 11: كَالْيَفُورُنِيَا Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? Both sound fairly correct, I think A is more pronounced.
- Word 12: الْبَحْر Which pronunciation sounds more "Arabic" to you? A B
Why? Both are similar, but I think the ° is present more in B rather than A.
